Second Grade High Frequency Word List 1 st Nine Weeks



The Second grade word lists were developed using the Fry Word List and the *Into Reading* (HMH) High-Frequency Word lists. Students should know the words from the previous grade levels as well as the ones from their current grade level list.

Tips for Teaching High-Frequency Words:

- 1. Introduce new words in isolation (i.e., the word by itself), but immediately follow this with repeated exposures to the same sight words in books and other reading materials. Students need to see the word used in context.
- 2. Provide brief but frequent sight word instruction. Each week introduce 5-7 words to your student. Making flashcards can be helpful.
- 3. Offer your student numerous opportunities to practice and receive immediate, specific feedback.

Each 9 weeks the students will be evaluated on their knowledge of these words.
